



## **Biomass – a Sustainable Investment Rediscovered at - 4th International Conference - Bioenergy in Romania**

**Biomass is the keyword that will dominate the renewable energy industry of Romania by 2020 - affirm foreign investors who show a growing interest in building heat and power plants that produce energy without polluting the environment. In order to achieve the proposed target 65% of the total renewable energy consumed will come from biomass, say the experts. Currently, the main source of biomass for the production of pellets, is the wood waste but for the future it is foreseen to be given by energy crops.
