



## **The 3rd International Conference - Solar Energy in Romania - Supports the Development of Solar Energy**

**Solar energy is an area that promises new opportunities both for foreign and Romanian investors. As a result, the production of photovoltaic modules has increased significantly over the past year and according to Transelectrica statistics the energy obtained in 2011 from the use of solar energy is of 1,007 MW out of total energy produced until now. RENEXPO® SOUTH-EAST EUROPE, the 4th energy trade fair of Romania, will bring together experts and key persons from this area to a central event, during 9-11/11/2011, at the Palace Hall in Bucharest.**

Transelectrica considers that in the next 20 years the energy demand will double in Romania. Also according to Romania's Energy Strategy, the solar potential of the country can generate 1,2 TWh of electricity annually, which means 2,5% from the current national consumption.

Even the foreign investors recognized the possibilities of this market and a Belgian company aims to complete by the end of next year, a solar park of about 30 mil. euro, which will have a capacity of 10 MW. This project will be developed on an area of 4 hectares, granted by the City Hall of Fierbinți, Ialomița county, for a period of 30 years.

For supporting the development and transfer of information in the solar energy field in Romania, REECO - international trade fair and conference organizer on renewable energy in the whole Europe, organizes the **3rd International Conference - Solar Energy in Romania**.
