



Wind Energy in Romania 2011 - Year of Growing Energy Parks in Romania

There were 448 MW energy installed last year in Romania, the biggest capacity from the former socialist countries, except Poland. For 2011 it is forecasted that other 700 MW will be installed. With the upcoming boom in the renewable energy sector, new opportunities are given for international and national machine and plant builders as well as manufacturers.

The biggest meeting point for wind energy sector in Romania will be organised in the framework of the RENEXPO® SOUTH-EAST EUROPE, Romania's 4th international energy trade fair.
